3. Chair Update - Thoughts so far

Positive feedback. More people are re-joining.

Suppliers keen to see return to face to face. Similar membership feedback. Overwhelming desire for face to face. Northern Ireland the exception.

Plans for 2022 – connect again. We haven't planned yet for the next 2-3 years. What do members want to see?

Partners, Andrew Trigg from HMLR keen to connect.

RICS keen to connect on webinar - James Kavanagh.

RGS meeting after today's Council – Nigel Clifford, Joe Smith, Liz Fox-Tucker, Catherine Souch. JCu advice – Joe is a massive advocate for the comms and AV capability they have invested in at RGS.

GC - AB meeting with Ros.

4. Partnerships Update

Partnerships meeting at 8am, 14 March. RD was absent due to sickness.

DM advice:

- Partner member brings revenue to organisation AGI must bring/demonstrate those benefits.
- All existing partnerships are off the back of some work
 e.g., competencies with CICES; for SSSI the career pathways, links between UK and Australia.
- A light touch partnership could be using AGI members to engage. We would then need a partnership lead on Council.

What benefit does a partnership bring our members?

How much resource does it need to realise that benefit?

Partner members - what benefits? RH

- HMLR what is a dedicated AGI account manager?
- David Henderson (OS) is AGI friend. Asks what our strategy is? What are the big 2 or 3 issues of this year?
- What benefits do staff get? Login to website.
- Sharing of AGI news adapt to partners.

AM – new partner leads should open conversation with our partners. Get insights from LPS, HMLR and ESRI for what they want to see for 2022. How can we help each other? This comes back to our own priorities for 2022.

Discussion of twin track for success of partner leads.

- Deliver value to staff, but also target the lead/senior contact.
- DM senior contacts find the insights and information most valuable. What are members talking about and what are the big issues? E.g. ethics gave a platform to engage and be seen to engage.
- Big ticket issues data space, policy issues. Breakfast meetings are ideal for invitation only discussion around policy. Nigel and Joe from RGS would be interested in this.

RH – if you are giving partners a platform you need an audience.

5. Events 2022

FC shared GeoCom22 paper today.

- Why GeoCom is important to AGI
- AWG established FC (Lead), ST, DM, RD, GF, Stephen Croney (ESRI), Mark Stileman (OS)
 - o FC wants to invite further people from membership onto AWG
- Physical 1 day event is proposed. Historically late November but proposes early Autumn.
- Quotations received from RGS and Royal Society. Royal Society hosted in 2019 because RGS was not available. Prestige venue to attract speakers.
 - 11 and 12 October at RGS is available.
- Paid attendance and paid sponsorship 200 250 attendees.
- FC feels it should be in-person only. Hybrid will decrease numbers on the day.

Suggest a save the date and a call for further AWG involvement.

A 2-day event would be good for sponsors. Feeds into ideas for awards ceremony.

DM – warning that bulk of preparation must be done before summer break. Royal Society was amazing as it drew senior leaders. They will only come for the day or session, not for a 2-day event.

MC – raised recommendations from GeoCom21 AWG about starting earlier and concerns about earlier date. Hosting the event earlier requires starting earlier, which we have not done. Repeated risk of people being absent over summer break and event programme and registration to be done by July.

Discussion around in-person vs hybrid.

- HG re-evaluate our income streams from events.
- DM can we stream events the following week to engage remote members?
- Hybrid of hybrid? Can we involve ECN?

- Potential to have awards the night before and collaborate with RGS (Monday night lectures)?
