# 3. Skills Update (AR)

We now have extended group – newly joined members include North Sea Transition Authority, Space Skills Alliance. Active group – meet last Wednesday of each month

Headlines from skills survey results, kindly collated by RGS

- Demographic 46% public sector, 38% private
- · Surprisingly optimistic responses around ability to recruit for skills now and into the future

#### Discussion

- Marketing preparing full report of survey results
- WG discussions some trends are not being revealed. Heidi (Space Skills Alliance) did preliminary analysis work. This led to proposal for Space Skills Alliance to perform a deeper analysis – at a cost of £2k.
- Heidi and Joseph (Space Skills Alliance and AGI Education and Skills WG) have disclosed their interest in this analysis work to the WG. AR brings this disclosure to Council today.
- Expecting the report to inform a high-profile session at GeoBusiness want to have report published the week before
